

## **New Covenant Freedom Bible Course Curriculum**

### **Curriculum Abstract**

This curriculum is designed to teach students the reality of the New Covenant as taught by Paul in his Epistles. The content is specifically designed to renew the mind of students (as per Romans 12:2) to understand what Jesus did for them by His death and resurrection. Embracing this material will deliver the student from the strongholds of self and of evil in their lives and show them how to live successfully in this world as a productive member of society – the way God intended it to be.

For many years humans have struggled with failure, wrong choices, violence, guilt, anti-social behavior and evil. But God has already provided the solution to these problems. The biggest hindrance to living free from these things is man thinking that by his own ability and efforts (the focus of psychology and psychiatry) he can overcome them. The only true solution to man's problems is to let God deliver man from himself. The New Covenant is what God has provided to do just that. It is why Jesus said "**the truth will make you free**". The truths in this course will bring a supernatural freedom to the student's life as they accept the revelations that God gives.

### **Curriculum Content Summary:**

#### **New Covenant Principles (7 lessons):**

There are seven foundational concepts (principles) that undergird the Christian life. Being grounded in these principles involves renewing the mind to agree with what God says about our lives. These principles enable the students to walk free from their past and from the snares of this evil world.

1. Forgiveness – Addresses how God views sin and what He has done to set us free from it.
2. Righteousness – Shows what God has done to restore our relationship with Him.
3. Salvation – Presents what Jesus did for man through His death and resurrection.
4. God is Good – Lays the foundation for being able to trust God in every situation.
5. Dominion – Presents the role God has given to us to perform in our daily lives.
6. You are Loved – Addresses how to receive God's love and let it change our lives.
7. Rest – Presents the secret to seeing the supernatural power of God released in our lives.

#### **Blood Covenant Truths (16 Lessons)**

There are seven truths about blood covenant that show students how serious God is about fixing their lives through the ironclad guarantee of Blood Covenant. They will get a foundation in God that enables them to overcome the trials and temptations of evil and to live a long, successful and satisfying life.

1. The Need for Covenant – Why God needed a blood covenant to deliver man.
2. Preparation of Covenant – How God set up the blood covenant in Jesus.
3. Blood Covenant Ceremony – the ten steps involved in making a covenant.

4. Abrahamic Covenant – The covenant that God cut with Abraham; the type of the New Covenant.
5. New Covenant Preparation – How God set up the New Covenant by Abraham’s obedience.
6. Old Covenant of Law – The Ten Commandments and their role in the lives of men.
7. New Covenant of Grace (10 lessons on this topic) – Why the old covenant was made obsolete and what the new covenant, that was cut and sealed in Jesus blood, has provided for us.

### **New Covenant Lifestyle (10 lessons)**

These lessons will release students from the thinking that causes failure and ungodly behavior. They will reveal to them how to live by the Spirit (Romans 8:1) with God’s power operating through them.

1. Old and New Covenant Comparison – Details of the differences between the covenants.
2. Communion Feast Reality – Explores the real purpose of the communion feast.
3. Understanding Job – Lessons from what happened to Job and why it happened.
4. God’s role in Trials – What is God’s role in the trials and tribulations of life.
5. Obedience by Faith – Understanding how to live the way God designed us to live, by faith.
6. Handling Finances – The reality of how to manage finances God’s way.
7. The Armor of God – Explains the purpose and use of the armor God has provided.
8. Living without Mixture – Shows how to live in the new covenant of God’s grace.
9. Living Stress Free – Presents how God enables us to live the life of rest that God wants for us.
10. Role of the Tongue – The taming of the small member that James calls the “rudder” of life.

### **New Covenant Inheritance (12 lessons)**

There are ten specific things that Jesus restored to man when He died. Knowing what this inheritance is and how to receive it will open up a whole new realm in the student’s relationship with God.

1. It’s all about Jesus – The beauty of His perfection and His completed work for all men.
2. Knowing what you Have – Jesus has a will (the new covenant terms) that came into force when He died. He is now the executor of His will and wants everyone to inherit what He died to give.
3. Joy – The first aspect of Jesus will; the strength given to man.
4. Victory – What Jesus purchased for every man.
5. Success – Jesus wants everyone to experience this in their lives.
6. Peace and Rest – Jesus paid for man to live in this state.
7. Protection – Jesus has purchased this for man and wants us to live in God’s protection.
8. Health & Boldness – God’s will is that all of His children should enjoy good health and long life.
9. Grace & Dominion – Jesus restored what Adam gave up in the garden of Eden.
10. Honor – Jesus wants Christians to live in honor and free from shame.
11. Wisdom & Provision – Jesus has provided everything needed for life and Godliness.
12. Discernment – Jesus has provided the Holy Spirit to lead, teach and comfort.

These 45 lessons will transform any person who receives and applies them into a dynamic force for good; one who lives the life God designed for them and who impacts those around them with God’s love. The new covenant in Jesus blood guarantees this – God has staked His reputation on it!
